# Day 1 (22 June 2024): Departure Cyprus LCA 20:10

# DAY 2 (23 June 2024): Kuala Lumpur ARRIVAL

Arrival Kuala Lumpur, Meet & greet by our representative at Kuala Lumpur International Airport then transfer to check in hotel. Overnight at a hotel in Kuala Lumpur. **Meals included: Dinner.** 

### DAY 3 (24 June 2024): KUALA LUMPUR 🖚

After breakfast, visit **Batu Cave** - is a **limestone** hill that has a series of caves and cave temples. The cave is one of the most popular Hindu shrines outside India, and is dedicated to Lord **Murugan.** It is the focal point of Hindu festival of **Thaipusam** in Malaysia. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon, continue visit National Mosque, Independence Square (Also name as Merdeka Square and Sultan Abdul Samad Building), New King's Palace (Outlook only), Thien Hau Temple, Photo session at iconic River of Life, Merdeka 118 (Slated to become the world's second tallest building) & Petronas Twin Tower. Shopping at China Town also name as Petaling Street. Overnight at a hotel in Kuala Lumpur.

#### DAY 4 (25 June 2024): KUALA LUMPUR 🏾 🏍 MALACCA 🌤 KUALA LUMPUR

Breakfast at hotel and proceed to Malacca by van/bus. It takes about 2 hours. On arrival, lunch at local restaurant. **Malacca tour**: Jonker Street, A Famosa (Porta of De Santiago), The Stadthuys (Red Square), Dutch Square Malacca and Cheng Hong Teng Temple. After tour, back to Kuala Lumpur. Dinner at own arrangement & expenses. Overnight at hotel in Kuala Lumpur. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch** 

# DAY 5 (26 June 2024): KUALA LUMPUR 🥗 SIEM REAP BY FLIGHT

After breakfast at the hotel, check out hotel then transfer airport for flight to Siem Reap. Arrival Siem Reap airport, meet & greet by Tour Guide and transfer to hotel for check in hotel. visit well preserved temple of **Banteay Srei**. Along the way we make stopover at the **Preah Dark village** and we follow these with a visit the **Banteay Samre Temple** adorned with impressive relief's depicting scenes of Vishunu as well as Krishna legends. Dinner at local restaurant **with Apsara show**. Overnight in Siem Reap

#### DAY 6 (27 June 2024) : SIEM REAP ANGKOR TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel, The sightseeing tour of Angkor area we spend a full day exploring the wondrous ancient ruins with the **South Gate of Angkor Thom**, which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive **Bayon Temple**, the Royal Enclosure, **Phimeanakas**, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and the largest as well as the most complete temple of **Angkor Wat**. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with Colums, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple and the jungle covered temple of **Ta Prohm** is an incredible sight. There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature. Overnight in Siem Reap.

# DAY 7 (28 June 2024): SIEM REAP ANGKOR NATIONAL MUSEUM KILLING

Breakfast at the hotel.Today we visit **Wat Thmey (Killing Fields)** the Wat Thmey Temple is notable for being an area that served as one of the killing fields during the Khmer Rouge regime in cambodia. Back to the city center and we will visit the **Angkor National Museum** known as the grand entrance to a world-class heritage site that reveals the glory of **Angkor Civilization**. This museum enhances the cultural heritage of the Golden Era of Khmer Kingdom through amassed collection of invaluable artifacts and through state-of-the-art multimedia technology exhibition for a full picturesque legendary story. We go to visit **Tonle Sap Lake**. The Tonle Sap one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. In the wet season, the Tonle Sap Lake swells three times its size flooding communities surrounding the lake, attracting a myriad of water birds as well as people, who have settled in villages along the shores and who live with the rhythm of the water. Take a boat trip with your tour guide to **Kampong Phluk fishin**g and floating villages in an atmospheric flooded jungle setting. Overnight in Siem Reap.

# DAY 8 ( 29 June 2024): SIEM REAP 🎏 BANGKOK BY FLIGHT

After breakfast at the hotel, check out hotel. Take a walk along the road in front of the King's Residence to see the Main Shrine, where the local people usually worship, with its statue of **YeayTeap**, **Preah Ang Chek** and **Preah Ang Chorm**. Buying jasmine and lotus flowers to

worship is very important for the Cambodians. And Visit to "**Les Artisans d'Angkor** - **Chantiers Ecoles**" of Siem Reap. local market "**Psachas**" where might get something for souvenirs back home. After lunch, transfer to airport for flight to BANGKOK.

Upon your arrival at Survanabhumi international airport with flight, you are warmly welcome by local guide and transfer to city center and then we visit the **Grand Palace** and **Temple of the Emerald Buddha (Wat Phra Kaew)**. Explore Thailand's iconic temple and discover the historical significance behind the **Throne Hall, the Emerald Buddha**, and more. Continue visit at **Wat Pho** (Temple of the Reclining Buddha). Pay respect to the golden **Reclining Buddha**, see the colorful gigantic pagodas, and spot the statues showcasing traditional Thai massage techniques. We will cross the **Chao Phraya River by boat** and arrive at **Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn)**. Climb the temple's famous prang (Khmer-style tower) and meet the giants. Back to your hotel and today sightseeing end. Have welcome dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Bangkok.

#### DAY 9 ( 30 June 2024) : BANGKOK 🌤 AYUTTHAYA TOUR 🌤 BANGKOK

Breakfast at hotel and today you will be picked up by local tour guide and drive north to Ayutthaya. On arrival you will visit **Wat Phu Khao Thong**, originally built in 1,387 by the second king of Ayothaya kingdom, is an impressive monument in North-western part of Ayutthaya. When the Burmese took over Ayutthaya in 1569, the Burmese king built a Mon-style chedi (or pyramid) on top of the former temple to celebrate his victory over Ayutthaya and the Siamese. Continue to the **Ayutthaya Historical Park** and visit the ancient palace ground. **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, once a royal temple lying beside the **Grand Palace**, was once the most significant temple during Ayutthaya period. Adjacent to Wat Phra Sri Sanphet is Viharn Phra Mongkolbopit, an impressive building that houses a large, seated bronze Buddha

image. Its rebuilt pristine hall was believed to be a replica of the old Assembly Hall of Ayutthaya. Have Thai buffet lunch then in the afternoon you will visit to **Wat Lokaya Sutha** to see the largest reclining Buddha of Ayutthaya with 8 meters high and 42 meters long. The Buddha image was made of brick and covered with plaster. Onward to **Wat Mahathat**, a classic temple ruin of Ayutthaya and famous for the picturesque Buddha head engulfed by the Bodhi tree roots. The foundation size and the remaining prangs and towers attest the significance during its time. End of the day drive back to Bangkok for overnight at hotel.

#### DAY 10 ( 01 July 2024): BANGKOK Solve FLOATING MARKET Solve RAILWAY MARKET Solve BANGKOK

07h30 am you are picked up at the lobby of your hotel in Bangkok city center and then proceed to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**. 09h00 arrive at the market in Ratchaburi is one of the most popular floating markets in Thailand. Every day many Thai and foreign tourists travel here to shop, eat, and absorb the atmosphere of Thailand water markets that have been like this for over 100 years. Damnoen Saduak is the straightest and longest canal in Thailand. The canal was built on royal initiative as King Rama IV of Thailand wated to link the Mae Klong River with Chinese river ways to support transportation and trade. It took over 2 years to dig, and was eventually finished under the reign of his successor King Rama V. The canal is 32 kilometers long and has more than 200 branches. Damnoen Saduak Floating Market's popularity grew to new heights in 1971 - 1973 when the river was full of farmers on their boats selling their wares. And that is the way trade is performed in this area until todays. Have lunch at a local restaurant then continue to the **Maeklong Railway Market**, locally called Talad Rom Hoop. It is exciting and fun to watch the merchants and vendors in a rush to fold and remove their goods and umbrellas away from the railway track while the Maekong Train is passing by. This market is open and closed 8 times a

day, since there are 4 trains passing up and down. Return to Bangkok and back to the hotel. Overnight in Bangkok.
